

Terms and Conditions

1. Competition begins Monday, 24th October 2011.
2. Competition closes Close of Business, Sunday 4th December 2011.
3. One Entry form per purchase of \$10 or more at a participating Nextra Group Outlet.
4. All entries must be on official entry forms and received at PO Box 3202, Newstead, Q, 4006 by 5.00pm (EST) Monday, 12th December 2011.

6. Winners will be notified by telephone and mail and published in The Australian (*Classifieds*) on Thursday 15th December 2011.
